Dr. Lorenzo Memeo earned his degree in Medicine from Sapienza University of Rome in 1997. At the same university, he later obtained his specialization diploma in Pathological Anatomy in 2003, graduating with top marks.

From 2001 to 2005, he served as a Postdoctoral Research Fellow at the New York Metropolitan Registry for Familial Breast and Ovarian Cancer at Columbia University in New York. During this period, Dr. Memeo focused on studying the role of the tumor suppressor gene PTEN in breast cancer.

Since 2005, after a brief period as a Clinical Fellow at ISMETT in Palermo and as a Visiting Fellow in the Department of Transplantation Pathology at the University of Pittsburgh, he has been Head of the Pathology and Molecular Diagnostics Service at the Mediterranean Oncology Institute in Viagrande (Catania).

Dr. Memeo is the author of more than 120 publications in international journals, including *Nature Medicine*, *Nature Genetics*, *Cancer Cell*, and *Cancer Research*, on oncology-related topics, with particular focus on breast, thyroid, gastrointestinal, and urogenital neoplasms.
