Livia Giordano is a Medical Doctor, working as epidemiologist at the Centre for Cancer Prevention in Turin (Italy) since 1991.

She has broad experience in research encompassing epidemiology, cancer screening, smoking cessation and communication strategies. I have also experience in conducting/analysing intervention studies.

She has been the president of Gisma (the Italian Group for Breast cancer screening programmes) from 2009 to 2015.

Her current main activity focuses on breast cancer screening evaluation and implementation both at local and national level. She is a key investigator of a RCT pilot project aiming to widespread healthier lifestyles among the population invited to perform a breast cancer screening (STI.VI trial) and the co-investigator of a project assessing the predictive value of combined risk criteria (breast density, reproductive factors, lifestyle habits and molecular biomarkers) for tailored breast cancer screening strategies (Andromeda study).

She is also involved in projects on social inequalities and barriers to screening accessibility in disadvantages people and in the evaluation of the sustainability of cancer screening activities in low-resource settings of the Mediterranean area (Euromed study).

She has been one of the authors of the chapters related to communication both in the '*European guidelines for quality assurance in breast cancer screening and diagnosis (fourth edition)*' and in the '*European guidelines for quality assurance in colorectal cancer screening and diagnosis (first edition)*'.
