Dr Paola Armaroli is an epidemiologist and medical doctor at the Reference Centre for Epidemiology and Cancer Prevention in Piedmont (CPO Piemonte), Italy. She has a Medical degree with a specialisation in Hygiene and Preventive Medicine, and a MSc in Epidemiology from the University of Turin.

She has worked at CPO Piemonte since 2003 and is involved in several national and international epidemiological studies and trials on cancer screening. She is actively involved in a number of European Commission funded initiatives on cancer prevention, including as a Member of the Working Groups on “EU cervical cancer screening guidelines - supplements on HPV testing and HPV vaccination”, is a lecturer for the screening module of the e-Learning programme of the “European Code Against Cancer”, and has worked on the “European Guidelines for Quality Assurance of Colorectal Cancer Screening”, in collaboration with the International Agency for Research on Cancer (IARC) Lyon, France.

She is responsible for the Piedmont cervical cancer screening program for data collection, analysis and evaluation and coordination of scientific research and national and international studies. She is also responsible for the National Survey (data collection, analysis and evaluation, reporting results to the Ministry of Health and dissemination of findings and outcomes) and coordinates the Working Group - "Organization and Evaluation" of the Italian Group for the Cervical cancer Screening (Gruppo Italiano Screening del Cervicocarcinoma GISCI).
