Arantzazu Arrospide is Head of the Planning Service at the Health Ministry of the Basque Government (Vitoria-Gasteiz, Spain). She has a degree in Mathematics, a PhD in Public Health, and a Masters degree in Health Service Management. She has worked as a researcher at the Basque Health Service – Osakidetza, and has authored around 60 scientific papers.

She developed her scientific career in the domain of health economics. Her principal expertise is the application of mathematical modelling in the epidemiological and economic evaluation of population-level interventions such as cancer screening.

She has worked with a range of simulation models to evaluate breast and colorectal cancer screening programmes in the Basque country, and is currently working with the coordination group of the Basque Country's population-level cervical screening programme to develop its evaluation framework and define its key quality indicators. She is also involved in EU Cancer Screening Scheme Implementation (EUCanScreen) project funded by the European Commission's EU4Health programme.
