Margaret Cruickshank is a consultant Gynaecologist with NHS Grampian, Scotland, and was previously Clinical Professor of Gynaecology and Co-lead of the Aberdeen Centre for Women's Health Research. She is an accredited colposcopist and colposcopy trainer with British Society for Colposcopy and Cervical Pathology (BSCCP).

She led the introduction of a national colposcopy system for clinical information and audit (NCCIAS) and introduced annual benchmarking at national level. She is a former President of the British Society for Colposcopy and Cervical Pathology, and currently President of the European Federation of Colposcopy. She also chairs the Education and Training Committee for the International Federation of Colposcopy and Cervical Pathology.

She has a programme of research in pre-invasive diseases of the lower genital tract, clinical research trials and molecular studies with Universities of Edinburgh, Dundee, Manchester, Nottingham and Strathclyde and NHS Scotland, and is chief investigator for a research programme on the impact of HPV immunisation on cervical screening, and the role of HPV testing as a primary screening tool.
