Paolo Giorgi Rossi has an MSc in Molecular Biology and a PhD in Cellular and Animal Biology from the University of Pavia, Italy.

Since 1998, he has worked for the Agency for Public Health of Lazio, Rome, Italy, where he was Director of the Health Technology Assessment Service from 2006 to 2012. He is currently Director of the Epidemiology Service in the Reggio Emilia Local Health Authority and Research Hospital (AUSL – IRCCS).

His principal interest is the evaluation of public health interventions, with a focus on cancer screening. He is the Principal Investigator of several epidemiological studies and trials on screening and has authored or co-authored over 450 scientific publications and over 50 monographs and book chapters.

He has served as the President of the Italian Cervical Cancer Screening Group and as a member of the coordinating committee of the Italian Mammographic Screening Group. He is a Working Group member of the European Commission Initiatives on Breast Cancer (ECIBC) and Colorectal Cancer (ECICC) for the collaborative development of European cancer screening guidelines. He also co-led the process of Italy's adoption of the measures set out in the European breast and cervical cancer screening guidelines.
