He obtained the MSc in Molecular Biology in 1994 and Ph.D. in Cellular and Animal Biology in 1998 at the University of Pavia (Pavia, Italy). While carrying out his PhD, he worked also at the Human genetics laboratory, National Research Council, Pavia, Italy and at the ELI Lilly Research Centre Limited, Earl Wood, Surrey UK.

Since 1998, he has been working at the Agency for Public Health of Lazio, Rome, Italy, where he directed the Health Technology Assessment Service from 2006 to 2012. Now he is the director of the Epidemiology Service in the Local Health Authority – IRCCS in Reggio Emilia. His principal interest is the evaluation of Public Health interventions; the fields in which he is involved are cancer prevention (screening and primary) and infectious diseases (in particular HTA of the new vaccines).

He is the principal investigator of several independent epidemiological studies and public health trials. He is the author or co-author of more than 400 publications indexed in PubMed and more than 50 monographs and book chapters. He has been the president of the Italian Cervical Cancer Screening Group, the scientific society of cervical cancer screening in Italy and he has been a member of the coordinating committee of the Italian Mammographic Screening Group. He is a member of the Guidelines Development Group for the European Commission Initiative on Breast Cancer.
